THE EXHAUST SYSTEM.

1. GENERAL.

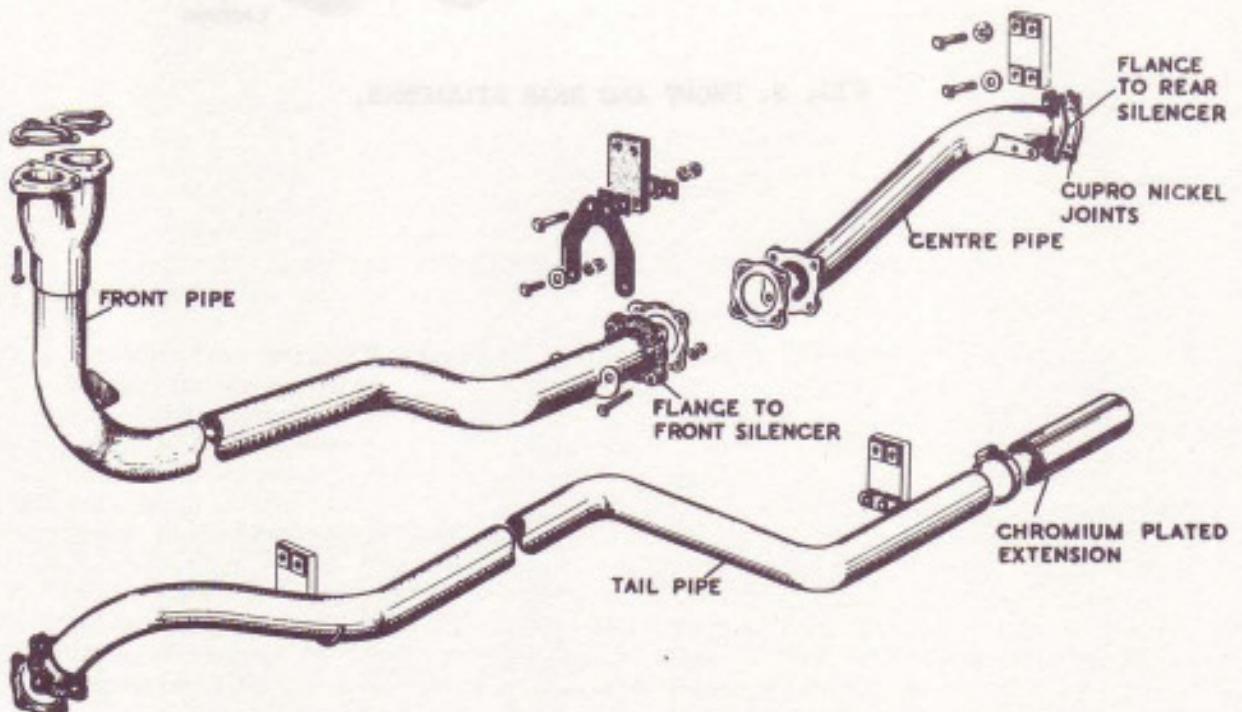


FIG. 1. EXHAUST PIPES

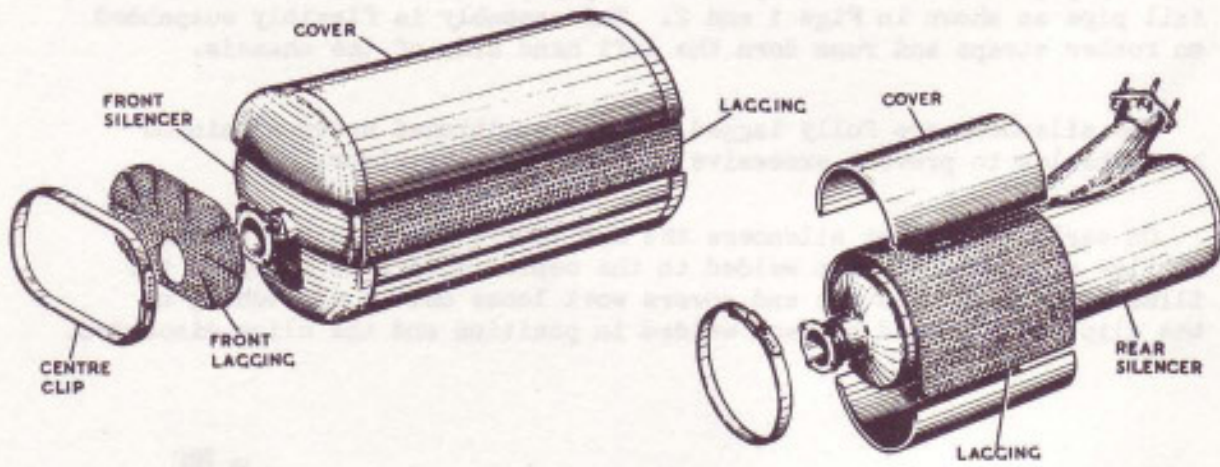


FIG. 2. FRONT AND REAR SILENCERS.

The exhaust system comprises, in addition to the twin manifold, a front pipe, a front silencer, a centre pipe, a rear silencer and a tail pipe as shown in Figs 1 and 2. The assembly is flexibly suspended on rubber straps and runs down the left hand side of the chassis.

The silencers are fully lagged and are positioned under aluminium heat shields to prevent excessive heat on the rear floor.

On early type front silencers the end covers are retained by two Jubilee clips and are not welded to the centre covers as shown in the illustration. Should the end covers work loose due to stretching of the clips they should be tack welded in position and the clips discarded.
